A 21-year singing member of GMCLA, he also sings and produces audio for its small a cappella ensemble, Aftershock. Lucio's experience in front of the mic and in the sound booth have yielded valuable insight on the best practices for obtaining the most favorable audio in a choral setting.

In his home studio, Lucio regularly handles the ingestion/import of hundreds of individual audio files for denoising and spectral cleanup before editing, mixing and mastering of the final product for broadcast or retail consumption.
